- Also pursued science as part of the Lunar Society in Birmingham (Erasmus, Darwin)
- Most of career was outside London (unrestricted)
- Caravaggio/Baroque influence

 STYLISTIC CHARACTERISTICS: (use of design elements/ principles: color, shape, value, texture, line, space; balance, contrast, emphasis, movement, etc.)

Chiaroscuro (trademark); candle lit subjects; scientists and philosophers in places usually reserved for biblical and mythical figures, showing science not in a technically correct way but an idealized way to show that it will drive society forward
